LEADER:

"Hello, friends! I'm so glad to see you today. Come join me on the floor.

Today's true story from the Bible (hold up the Bible) begins when Jesus told

His friends, the disciples, (hold up the picture of Jesus and the disciples)

'You are the light of the world.' You can be a light too."

"When you are kind, (hold up the picture of children playing on the playground) when you forgive, (hold up the picture of children hugging/apologizing) when you share, (hold up the picture of children sharing a toy) and when you help, (hold up the picture of a brother getting something from a shelf for his sister) your light shines and people can see that Jesus is kind, He helps, and He shares. When you do what Jesus says, YOU shine your light so people can see that Jesus loves them and wants to be their friend forever. YOU can do that! [Bottom Line] You can do what Jesus says."
